


Gossips want every little tidbit of information and become irritated if they aren't told everything that is going on in detail.





Gossips seldom pray but immediately begin thinking about others to tell and are quick to grab the cellphone, post to Facebook or hit the "send" button.






Gossips delight in the sin of others and seldom recognize their own sinful actions.




Bears



Greek: pisteu pist-yoo -o; to have faith. To grant or extend credit to. To deploy, extend, put forward the best thought first.




Agape Love is not suspicious or cynical. It is an encouraging love that wants to see others succeed, progress and to develop. This love believes in and supports each other.








Endures- Greek: hypomenō to remain or to be present. To tarry close behind, to remain within reach, to abide with or stay near.






