1 Corinthians 10: 23 (ESV)

But take care that this right of yours does not somehow become a stumbling block to the weak.

1 Corinthians 10: 24 (ESV)

*Let no one seek his own good,
but the good of his neighbor.*

1 Corinthians 10: 25-26 (ESV)

Eat whatever is sold in the meat market without raising any question on the ground of conscience. For “the earth is the Lord's, and the fullness thereof.”

1 Corinthians 10: 27 (ESV)

If one of the unbelievers invites you to dinner and you are disposed to go, eat whatever is set before you without raising any question on the ground of conscience.

If someone who isn't a believer asks you home for dinner, accept the invitation if you want to. Eat whatever is offered to you without raising questions of conscience.

1 Corinthians 10: 28 (NLT)

*But suppose someone tells you,
“This meat was offered to an
idol.” Don’t eat it, out of
consideration for the
conscience of the one who told
you.*

Paul insists that the believers in Corinth avoid giving even the slightest bit of knowing support to idol worship to show unbelievers that they are separated from it. Those who do not know Christ should not be confused about who Christians worship.



Unbelievers should know both from the words and the actions of the believers that Christians worship Christ alone and no other gods.

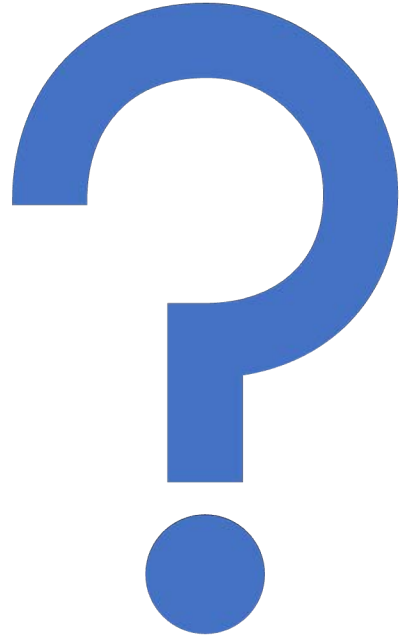
Paul is clear about the motive: Refusing to eat meat known to have been offered to an idol should be done for the sake of the person who told them about it, for the conscience of the unbeliever.

1 Corinthians 10: 29-30 (ESV)

**I do not mean your conscience,
but his. For why should my liberty
be determined by someone else's
conscience? If I partake with
thankfulness, why am I
denounced because of that for
which I give thanks?**

1 Corinthians 10: 31-32 (ESV)

*So, whether you eat or drink,
or whatever you do, do all to
the glory of God. Give no
offense to Jews or to Greeks or
to the church of God,*





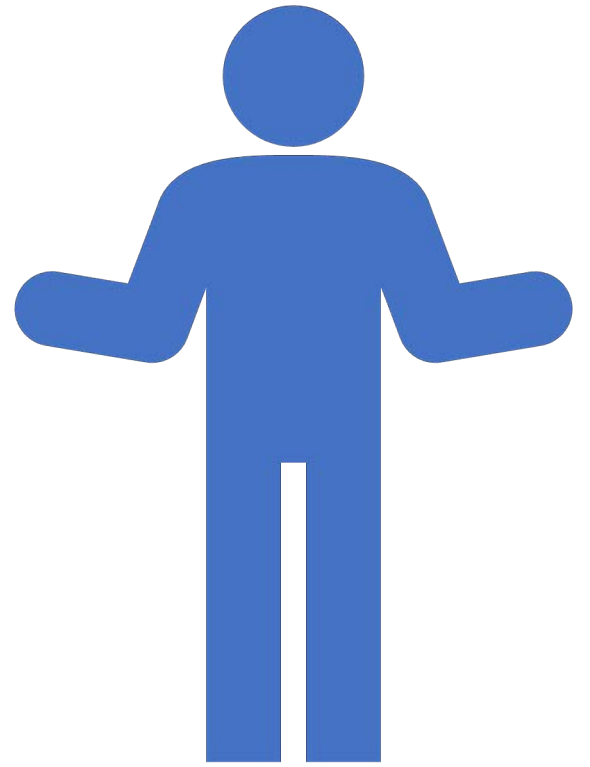

1 Corinthians 11: 4 (NASB)

*Every man who
has something on his head
while praying or prophesying
disgraces his head.*

1 Corinthians 11: 5 (NASB)

But every woman who has her head uncovered while praying or prophesying disgraces her head, for it is one and the same as the woman whose head is shaved.

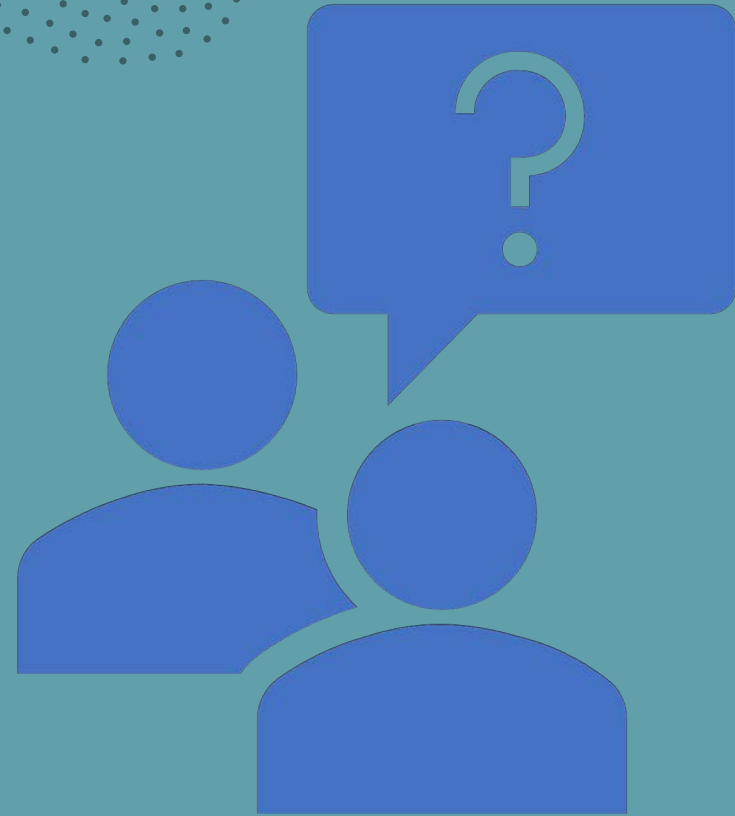
1 Corinthians 11: 6 (NASB)

For if a woman does not cover her head, have her also cut her hair off; however, if it is disgraceful for a woman to have her hair cut off or her head shaved, have her cover her head.

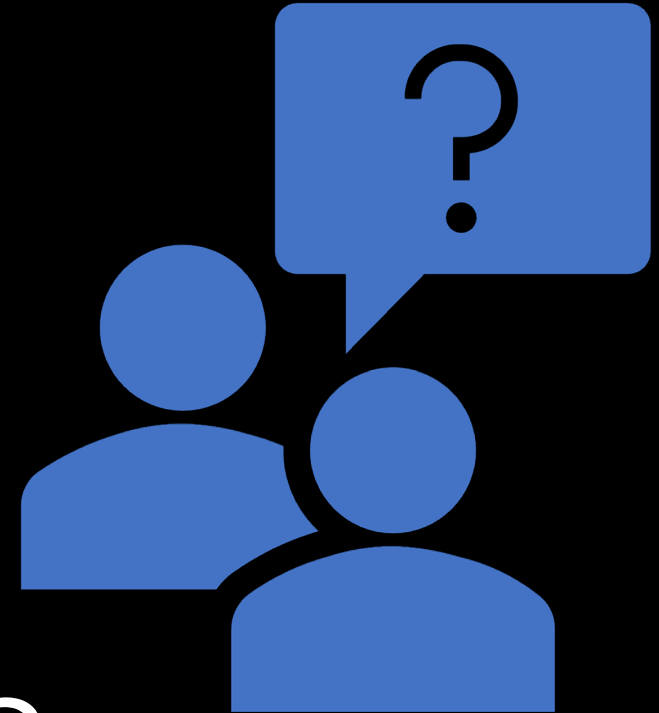
1 Corinthians 11: 7 (NASB)

For a man should not have his head covered, since he is the image and glory of God; but the woman is the glory of man.

1 Corinthians 11: 8-9 (NASB)

For man does not originate from woman, but woman from man; for indeed man was not created for the woman's sake, but woman for the man's sake.

1 Corinthians 11: 10 (NASB)

Therefore the woman should have a symbol of authority on her head, because of the angels.

1 Corinthians 11: 10 (NLT)

For this reason, and because the angels are watching, a woman should wear a covering on her head to show she is under authority.

1 Corinthians 11: 11 (NASB)

*However, in the Lord, neither is
woman independent of man,
nor is man independent of
woman.*

1 Corinthians 11: 12 (NASB)

*For as the
woman originated from the
man, so also the man has his
birth through the woman;
and all things originate from
God.*

Paul is telling us that
without God we would not
be here. Without man,
woman would not be here
and without woman man
would not be here!

1 Corinthians 11: 13-14 (NASB)

Judge for yourselves: is it proper for a woman to pray to God with her head uncovered? Does even nature itself not teach you that if a man has long hair, it is a dishonor to him,

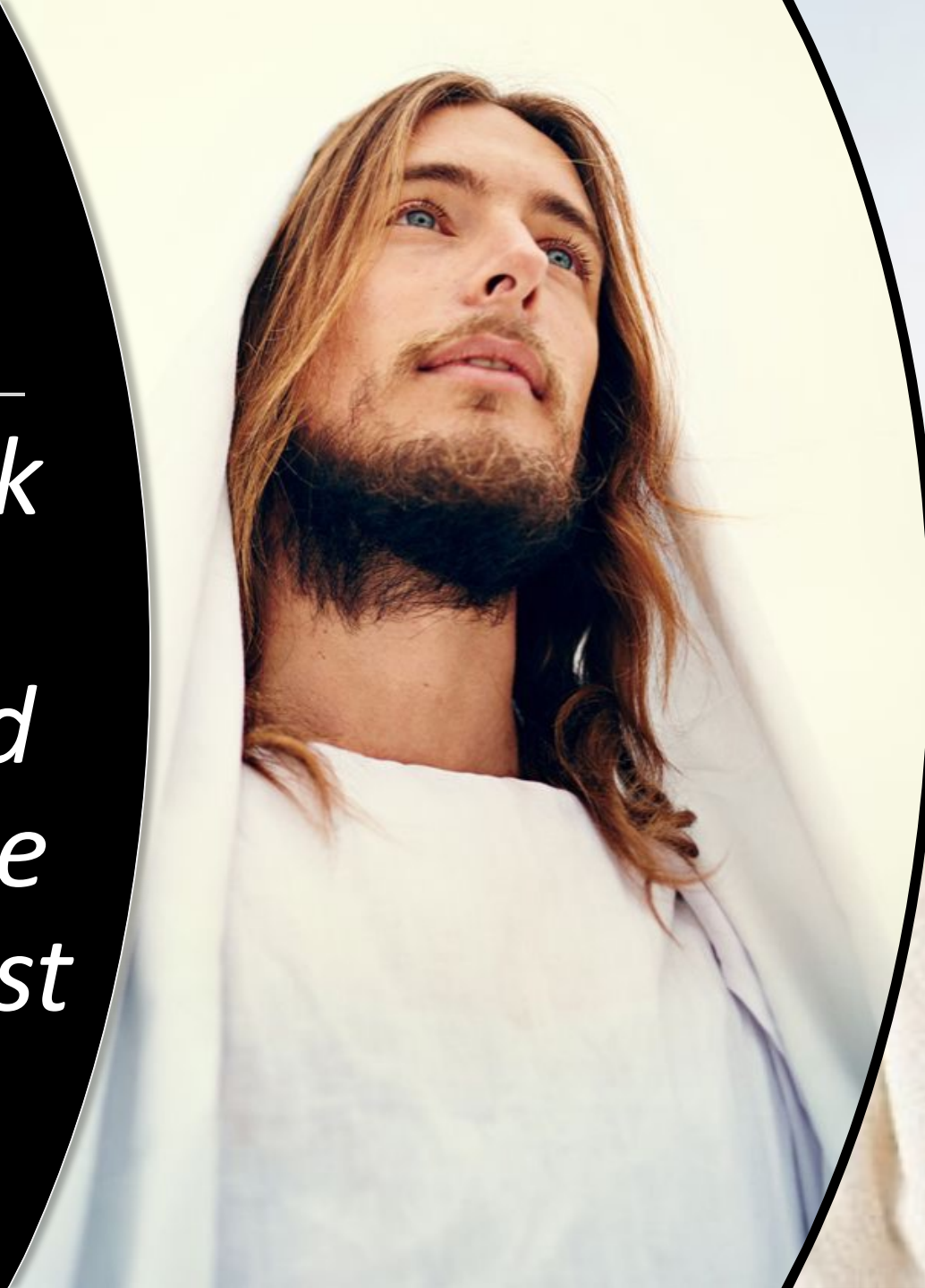
1 Corinthians 11: 15 (NASB)

but if a woman has long hair, it is a glory to her? For her hair is given to her as a covering.

The Bible does not tell us how long our hair should be, however the Bible does say that a man should look and act like a man and a woman, like a woman.

Also, many pagan cults during Paul's time often required male members to have long hair and women who served as shrine prostitutes would have shaved heads.

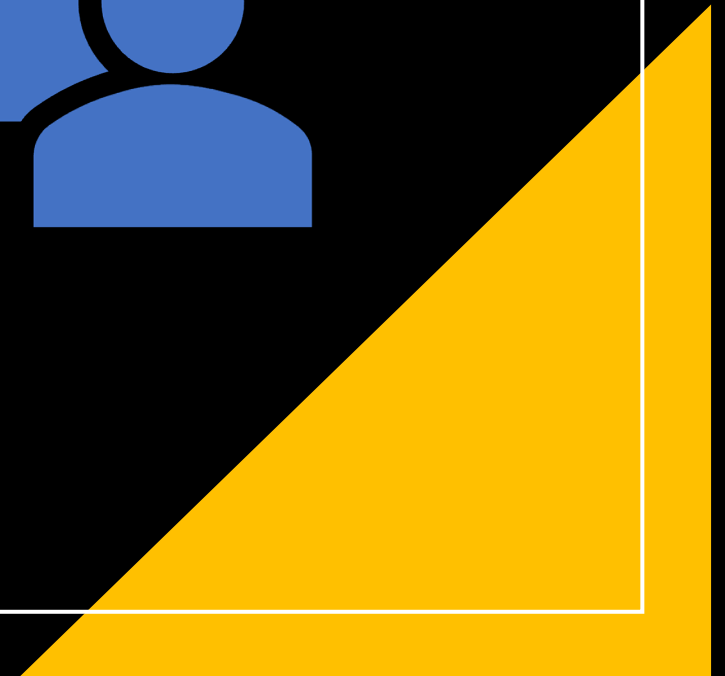
