Gentleness

How do you define gentlenes?

Oxford Dictionary:

1. The quality of being kind, tender, or mild-mannered.

'Michael was admired for his gentleness and tolerance'

2. Softness of action or effect; lightness. 'the gentleness of his touch'

Baker's Evangelical Dictionary of Biblical Theology:

Sensitivity of disposition and kindness of behavior, founded on strength and prompted by love.

Paul uses two Greek words for gentleness

epieikeia-a thoughtful, considerate and decent outlook

prautes-mild medication or easy on the stomach. This word is also used in reference to a tamed animal (controlled strength)

Gentleness Is an Expected Component of our Lives

2 Timothy 2: 24-26

And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but must be kind to everyone, able to teach, not resentful.

Opponents must be gently instructed, in the hope that God will grant them repentance

leading them to a knowledge of the truth, and that they will come to their senses and escape from the trap of the devil, who has taken them captive to do his will.

What is the hope we have when we are gentle that is described in the passage in 2 Timothy that we just read?

in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth, and that they will come to their senses and escape from the trap of the devil, who has taken them captive to do his will.

Our Gentleness in speaking Truth gives us hope that God will use us to bring others:

- 1. To repentance
- To knowledge of the truth
 To their senses
- 4. Out of the trap of the devil

Titus 3: 1-2 Remind the people to be subject to rulers and authorities, to be obedient, to be ready to do whatever is good, to slander no one, to be peaceable and considerate, and always to be gentle toward everyone.

Does it take strength to be gentle when others are being hostile toward you?

John 8: 1-11

1 Peter 3: 15 But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect

Matthew 26: 67

Then they spit in his face and struck him with their fists. Others slapped him and said, "Prophesy to us, Messiah. Who hit you?"

Matthew 27: 39-43

Those who passed by hurled insults at him, shaking their heads and saying, "You who are going to destroy the temple and build it in three days, save yourself!

Come down from the cross, if you are the Son of God!" In the same way the chief priests, the teachers of the law and the elders mocked him. "He saved others," they said, "but he can't save himself!

He's the king of Israel! Let him come down now from the cross, and we will believe in him. He trusts in God. Let God rescue him now if he wants him, for he said, 'I am the Son of God."

Luke 23: 34

Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing."

Isaiah 40: 10 See, the Sovereign Lord comes with power, and he rules with a mighty arm.

See, his reward is with him, and his recompense accompanies him.

Isaiah 40: 15 Surely the nations are like a drop in a bucket; they are regarded as dust on the scales; he weighs the islands as though they were fine dust.

Isaiah 40: 25-26 "To whom will you compare me? Or who is my equal?" says the Holy One. Lift up your eyes and look to the heavens: Who created all these?

He who brings out the starry host one by one and calls forth each of them by name. Because of his great power and mighty strength, not one of them is missing.

Isaiah 40: 11 He tends his flock like a shepherd: He gathers the lambs in his arms and carries them close to his heart: he gently leads those that have young.

Psalm 18: 35 (NASB) You have also given me the shield of Your salvation, And Your right hand upholds me;

And Your gentleness makes me great.

Philippians 4: 5

Let your **gentleness** be evident to all. The Lord is near.

Are men called to be Gentle? 1 Thessalonians 2: 5-8 (NASB) For we never came with flattering speech, as you know, nor with a pretext for greed—God is witness— nor did we seek glory from men, either from you or from others

even though as apostles of Christ we might have asserted our authority. But we proved to be gentle among you, as a nursing mother tenderly cares for her own children.

Having so fond an affection for you, we were wellpleased to impart to you not only the gospel of God but also our own lives, because you had become very dear to us.
